

Using Cimple.NET with IE7 / Windows Vista

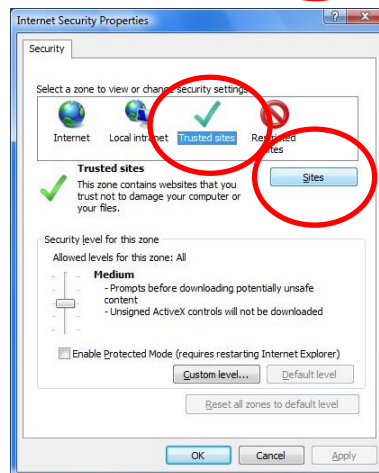
Due to the increased security options in Internet Explorer 7 / Windows Vista, you may have to change some settings in Internet Explorer in order for the Cimple.NET Toolbar to display properly and to be able to print preview.

The following steps will help you make the necessary changes to Internet Explorer 7 to use Cimple.NET through the web:

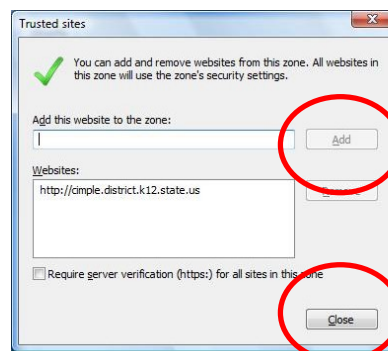
1. Once you are at the Cimple.NET site, double-click the Internet Zone icon on the status bar.



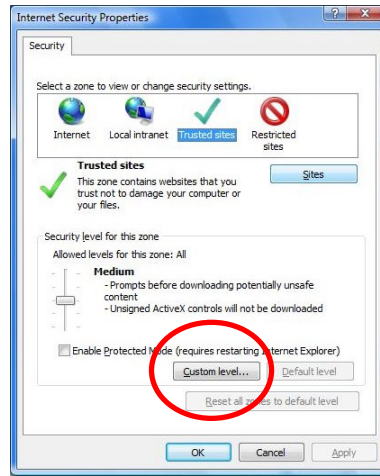
2. The Internet Security Properties window will appear. Select the "Trusted Sites" icon and then click the "Sites" button.



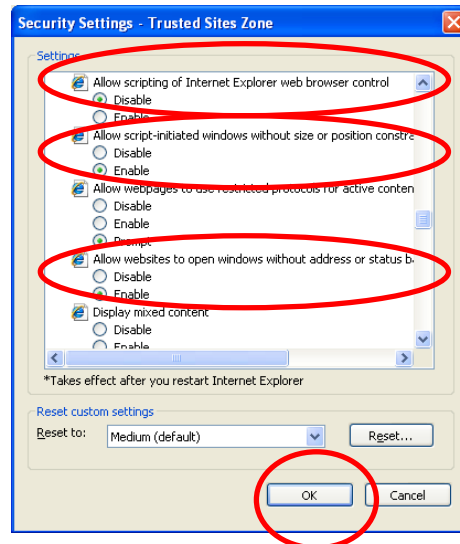
3. The "Trusted Sites" window will appear and the Cimple.NET website will appear in the box labeled "Add this website to the zone". Click the "Add" button. The Cimple.NET website should now appear in the list box named "Websites". Click "Close" to continue.



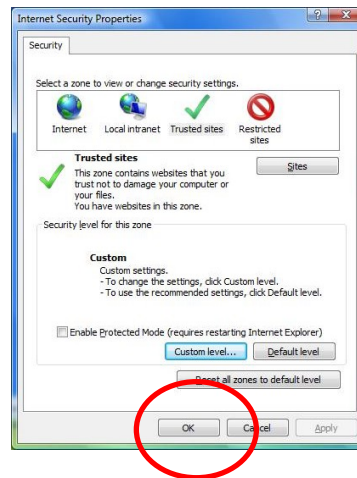
4. Next, click the “Custom Level” button on the “Internet Security Properties” window.



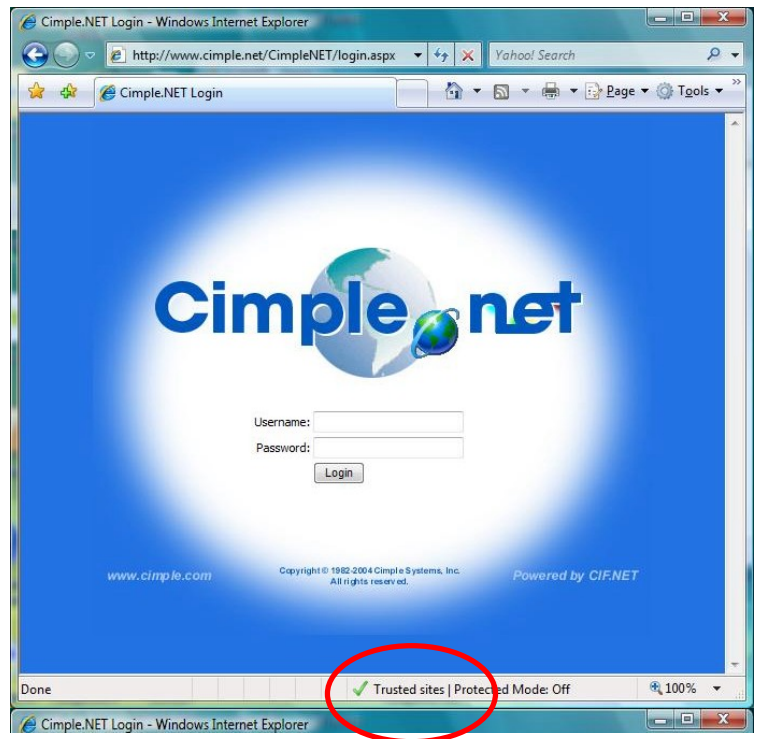
5. The “Security Settings – Trusted Sites Zone” window will appear. The following options must be Enabled: “Allow scripting of Internet Explorer web browser control”, “Allow script-initiated windows without size or position constraints”, and “Allow websites to open windows without address or status bars”. (These three options allow the Cimple.NET toolbar and toolbar windows to display properly, and allow the print preview feature to work properly). Then click the “OK” button. If prompted “are you sure you want to change settings for this zone” click “Yes”.



6. The following screen should appear. Click “OK” again to close this window and save your changes.

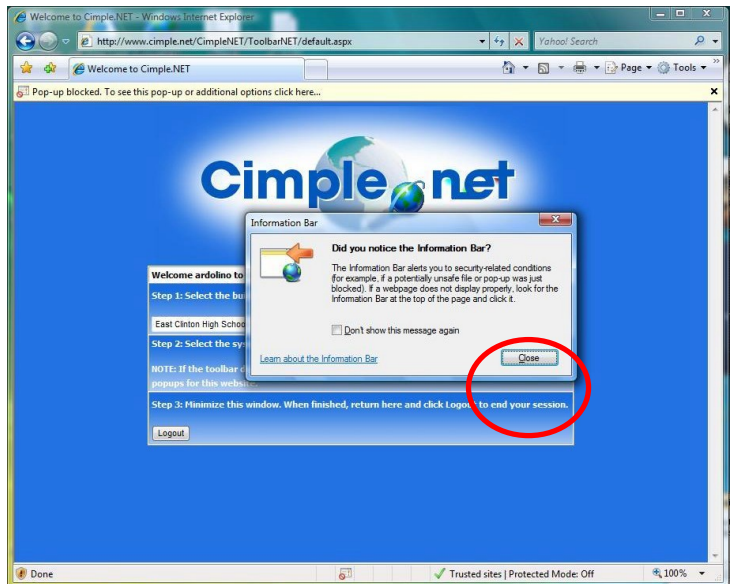


7. The Cimple.NET website should now appear as a trusted site (see status bar on the bottom).



8. Now login to the website and answer your security questions, if prompted. Once you get to the Cimple.NET Welcome page, you may notice that Internet Explorer's popup blocker has blocked the toolbar. If a dialog box appears regarding the Information Bar, click the "Close" button to continue.

WARNING: You may have another pop-up blocker installed within Internet Explorer that is also blocking pop-up windows (e.g. Google Toolbar). There is usually a button on the third-party toolbar that allows you to turn off the pop-up blocker. Consult the vendor of the third-party pop-up blocker for more information on how to allow pop-ups for this website.



9. If Internet Explorer is blocking the pop-up window, right-click the yellow information bar at the top and choose the option "Always Allow Pop-ups from This Site". When prompted, click "Yes" to allow pop-ups. Once you do this, the Cimple.NET toolbar will appear. You may have to refresh your browser window for the Cimple.NET toolbar to appear.

You can now use the Cimple.NET web interface with Internet Explorer 7.
